Entries

Closing date of entries is August 27th, 2010. After that time entries will be accepted with a post entry fee of **\$25**. After August 27th there will be no refund on stalls. Please be sure to mail in your complete entry form with an open check or payment to cover your entries. Juniors will need the signature of their parent or legal guardian to participate. Exhibitors are responsible for any errors or omissions on their entry forms.

Make checks payable to Stoney Ridge Farm.

Stabling

Stalls will be **\$85**. Stalls will be reserved on a first pay, first serve basis. Stalls will be permanent stalls in permanent buildings and/or 10' x 10' vinyl stalls in the indoor ring. No first bedding provided. Shavings will be available for purchase @ **\$8** per bag. Stalls will be available Thursday at 10AM.

Trailer in fees are **\$30** per day. Check with management for where to park your trailers.

Non showing horses will be charged **\$75** plus the EMT fee in addition to the stabling.

Class fees

MHJA recognized hunter, jumper & equitation classes will be **\$18** per class.

MHJA Medal Final classes will be **\$25** per class.

Warm-up, schooling hunter and training jumper classes will be **\$25** with **\$2** of each entry being awarded to the class winner.

Classic and Derby entry fees are **\$35**.

Posted orders of go will be used in all medal classes. The orders for the finals will be drawn on Saturday evening at the conclusion of the show day.

Riders showing in classes not properly entered in will pay a rode not entered fee of **\$6** per class.

Any non negotiable checks will be charged a service fee of \$50.

Any prize money won will be deducted from your entries. Any money owed the exhibitor will be mailed to the owner of record within 30 days.

Schooling

Schooling will be available on Thursday at 12:00 noon. No schooling over medal courses. Schooling will be available on show mornings until 7AM.

Campers

Camper spaces are **\$85** for the weekend. Camper fees should be paid directly to Hunter's Run.

Ribbons/Trophies

In all hunter classes ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.

All equitation classes ribbons will be awarded through eighth place

Classics will award ribbons through tenth place.

Championships will be awarded in all hunter and jumper divisions.

MHJA

This show will be run according to the rules of the MHJA. Any questions regarding the MHA rules should be directed to the Rules, Standards and Grievance Committee. Any rules not covered by the MHJA Rule Book will be referred to the USEF Rule Book.

Management

Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide classes if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Stoney Ridge Farm, Hunter's Run, the facility owners and their staffs will not be responsible in any way for loss or damage to any person, property, animal or equipment. Each exhibitor shall assume all liability and hold harmless Stoney Ridge Farm, Hunter's Run, the facility owners and their staffs for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or equipment that may be caused by any horse/pony entered by them or due to carelessness or negligence of the person in charge of such horse/pony or any of their subordinates or superiors.

Protective Headgear

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds (professionals included). Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until the headgear is properly in place. Stoney Ridge Farm and MHJA make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element or risk.

Dogs

All dogs must be on a leash at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the Observation Room. Please keep your dogs under control for the safety of everyone at the show.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Fences will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxers, post and rails, gate, aiken and panels.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.

A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each division. In addition to these points, only these horses will receive full points for the under saddle class.

Schooling Hunter - Open to all horses and riders. No championships.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses in their first year of showing over fences. Horses may compete in the Baby Green Hunter and the Very Green Hunter during the same show year.. Fences 2'6"-2'9".

Green Hunter

A First Year Green Hunter is a horse in its first year of showing over fences of any height. Fences 3'.

A Second Year Green Hunter is a horse in its second year of showing over fences of any height. Fences 3'3".

* Horses may show in classes, in which the fence height specifications do not exceed 2'9" for one show year and still be eligible to compete in the First Year Green division the following show year. Horses may compete in under saddle classes and equitation on the flat classes without affecting their green status.

Regular Working Hunter - Open to horses of any age regardless of their showing experience. Fences 3'6".

Non Professional Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult riders. Fences 3'.

Junior Working Hunter - Open to Junior riders. Divisions - Junior Hunter 14 & Under and Junior Hunter 15-17. Fences 3' - 3'3"

Open Adult Hunter - Open to Adult riders. Riders may not cross enter into the Limit Adult Hunter division at the same show. Fences 3' - 3'3".

Limit Adult Hunter - Open to Adult riders. Riders in this division may not cross enter into the Open Adult Hunter division at the same show or show in any classes that require the rider to jump 3'3" or higher at the same show. Fences 2'9"-3".

JUMPERS

All jumper classes will be run using one of the following jumper tables: Table 2.2b, Table 2.2c and/or Table IV. All ties for other than first place will be awarded according to time taken to complete the course. Ties for first place will be decided by a jump off.

Low Training Jumper - Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Fences 2'9". No championship. Entry fee **\$25**

Training Jumper - Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Fences 3'. No championship. Entry fee **\$25**.

Novice Children's/Adult Jumper - Open to Junior and Adult riders. Riders in this division may not show in any classes 3' or higher. Fences 2'6".

Low Schooling Jumper - Open to all horses and riders. Fences 2'9".

Low Children's/Adult Jumper - Open to Junior and Adult riders. Riders in this division may not cross enter the High Children's/Adult or Modified Jumper divisions on the same horse at the same show. Fences 3'.

High Children's/Adult Jumper - Open to Junior and Adult riders. Riders in this division may not cross enter the Low Children's/Adult Jumper division on the same horse, at the same show.

Schooling Jumper - Open to all horses and riders. Fences 3'6".

Modified Jumper - Open to all horses and riders. Fences 3'9"- 4'.

CLASSICS

The classics will be run under Table II 2a. These classes do not count toward MHJA year end championships, but do count for show championships. To compete in any of the classics horse/rider combinations must have completed 2 jumper classes. Entry **\$35**

\$500 Low Children's/Adult Jumper Classic Fences 3'

\$500 High Children's/Adult Jumper Classic Fences 3'3"- 3'6"

\$500 SRF Jumper Classic Fences 3'6"

MEDALS

MHJA Open Junior Medal Final - Open to Junior riders who have qualified for the 2010 final. Fences 3'3". Tests 1-19.

MHJA Open Adult Medal Final - Open to Adult riders who have qualified for the 2010 finals. Fences 3'. Tests 1-19.

MHJA Limit Junior Medal Final - Open to Junior riders who have qualified for the 2010 finals. Fences 3'. Tests 1-11.

MHJA Limit Adult Medal Final - Open to Adult riders who have qualified for the 2010 finals. Fences 2'9". Tests 1-8, 10.

MHJA Young Riders Medal Final - Open to Junior riders 14 years and younger who have qualified for the 2010 finals. Fences 2'9". Tests 1-8, 10.

MHJA Mini Medal—Open to riders who are eligible to participate in the beginner divisions and are current members of the MHJA. This is a 2010 qualifying class. The final will be held at the Stoney Ridge Farm "C" & Pony Show being held September 18-19. Complete specs will be available at the secretary's stand or on the MHJA website. (www.mhja.org) Entry fee **\$20**.

Medal Warm Up - Open to Junior and Adult riders. Fences 2'9", 3' & 3'3". Entry fee **\$25**.

\$500 STONEY RIDGE FARM HUNTER DERBY

This class will be run in a two round format. The first round will be a classic course consisting of 10 to 12 jumps 3' in height that could be found in the hunting field. Riders may receive bonus points for jumping the high options (3'3") in this round. All riders will receive a numeric score for the first round. The top 12 riders will return for the second round, which will be a handy round consisting of 8 to 10 jumps. Bonus points will be awarded for jumping the high options as well as the handiness of the round. The rider with the highest 2 round score will be the winner. Fences 3', high options 3'3". Horse/rider combinations must have completed 2 hunter classes to be eligible for this class. Entry fee **\$35**

Adult Hunter 18-35—Open to Adult riders 18-35 years of age. Riders may cross enter the Novice or Limit Adult Hunter divisions, but not both. Riders may not cross enter the Open Adult Hunter division or any Open Adult Equitation classes, or any classes requiring the rider to jump 3'3" or higher at the same show. Fences 2'6"

Adult Hunter 36 & Over - Open to Adult riders 36 & Over. Same specifications as the Adult Hunter 18-35 division.

Novice Ridden Adult Hunter - Open to Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons over fences in hunter classes at MHJA Regular Member shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized hunter classes at USEF & MHSA shows (see rule X Part III). Riders may not have shown in classes that require the rider to jump 3'3" or higher. Competing in classes 3'3" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders may not cross enter into the Open Adult Hunter division. Fences 2'6" 2'9".

* Riders may cross enter into the Adult Amateur Hunter division & Classic at USEF recognized shows. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division.

Novice Ridden Junior Hunter - Open to Junior riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons over fences in hunter classes at MHJA Regular Member shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized hunter classes at USEF & MHSA shows (see Rule X, Part III). Riders may not cross enter into the Junior Hunter divisions. Riders may not have shown in any classes that require the rider to jump 3'3" or higher. Competing in classes 3'3" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Fences 2'6" - 2'9".

* Riders may cross enter into the Children's Hunter division & Classic at USEF recognized shows. Winning 15 points at USEF shows will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division.

Children's Hunter - Open to Junior riders. This division is not open to riders who have shown in classes which require the rider to jump 3'6" or higher. Competing in classes 3'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders in this division may cross enter into the Junior Hunter division during the current show year, riders then become ineligible to compete in the Children's Hunter division the following year. Fences 2'9"- 3'.

Beginner Hunter - Open to Junior & Adult riders on horses or ponies. Separate divisions for Junior and Adult. Riders in these divisions may not have won 3 blue ribbons in any recognized hunter classes at MHJA and/or USEF horse shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner division do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. Riders may not show in classes 2'6" or higher. Fences 2'. No oxers.

Crosspole Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult riders on horses or ponies with limited show experience. Riders may not have shown higher than 2'. Trotting is permitted.

EQUITATION CLASSES

Junior Equitation 14 & Under - Open to Junior riders 14 years of age and under Fences 3'. Tests 1-8. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

Junior Equitation 15-17 - Open to Junior riders 15-17 years of age. Fences 3'3" Tests 1-19 (Rule XIV). In the flat class, any tests must be on the flat.

Limit Junior Equitation - Open to Junior riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation classes over fences at MHJA & USEF Regular Member shows. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in classes which require the rider to jump 3'6" or higher. Competing in classes 3'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders in this division may cross enter into the open equitation divisions (Junior Equitation 14 & Under and Junior Equitation 15-17). Fences 2'9"- 3', no tests. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

Novice Junior Equitation - Open to Junior riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in equitation classes over fences at MHJA Regular member shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF & MHSA shows (see Rule X, Part III). This division is not open to any rider who has shown in classes that require a rider to jump 3'3" or higher. Competing in classes 3'3" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders in this division may cross enter the Limit Junior Equitation division and the Young Riders Medal. Riders may not cross enter into the Open Junior Equitation divisions or the Open Junior Medal.

* Riders may compete in the Children's Hunter division at USEF shows. Winning 15 points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this Division. Fences 2'6"- 2'9", no tests. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

Low Adult Equitation - Open to Adult riders. Not open to professionals. Riders may not cross enter any classes requiring the rider to jump 3'3" or higher at the same show. Riders may not cross enter the Open Adult Hunter, Open Adult Equitation or Open Adult Medal at the same show. Fences 2'6", no tests. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

Novice Adult Equitation - Open to Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in equitation classes at MHJA Regular Member shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF & MHSA shows. This division is not open to any rider who has shown in classes that require the rider to jump 3'3" or higher. Competing in classes 3'3" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders may not cross enter into the Open Adult Equitation division or the Open Adult Medal. Riders may cross enter the Limit Adult Equitation division /Limit Adult Medal.

* Riders may compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter division & Classic at USEF shows. Winning 15 points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Fences 2'6", no tests. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

Limit Adult Equitation - Open to Adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation classes over fences at MHJA & USEF Regular Member shows. This division is not open to riders who have shown in classes which require the rider to jump 3'6" or higher. Competing in classes 3'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders may cross enter the Open Adult Equitation division/Open Adult Medal. Fences 2'9", no tests. Flat - Tests 1-5, 8.

* Riders may compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter division & Classic at USEF shows.

Open Adult Equitation - Open to Adult riders. Riders may cross enter into the Limit Adult Equitation division. Fences 3'. Flat - Tests 1-19.

Beginner Equitation - Open to Junior & Adult riders on horses or ponies who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized equitation classes at MHJA and/or USEF horse shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner division do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA and/or USEF horse shows. Riders may not cross enter into any classes requiring the rider to jump 2'6" or higher. Showing in classes 2'6" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for these classes. Fences 2'. No oxers. There will be separate classes for Junior & Adult riders, entries permitting.

Crosspole Equitation - Open to Junior & Adult riders on horses or ponies, with limited show experience and have not shown higher than 2'. Trotting is permitted.
