INTERMEDIATE MEDAL FINALS—Open to Junior and Adult riders who have qualified for the 2010 medal finals. Separate classes for Junior and Adult riders.

\$250 SRF INTERMEDIATE , PRIMARY AND BEGINNER CLASSICS

Open to riders who have participated in their respective divisions. Time permitting these classics will be two rounds, if we need to use one of the preceding hunter trips as the first round score all riders who have entered the classic will compete in the second round. If we have time for a two round classic (s) only the top 12 riders will return for the second round. The rider with the lowest score in the first round will return first in the second round. The rider with the highest two round score will be the class winner. Entry fee **\$35**.

1st- \$90, 2nd-\$50, 3rd-\$40, 4th-\$25, 5th-\$25, 6th-\$20, 7th-10th-ribbons

“C” DIVISIONS

VERY GREEN HUNTER - Open to horse in their first year of showing over fences. Horses may cross enter the Regular Member Baby Green Hunter Division during the current show season, but will be ineligible to compete in that division the following show season. Fences 2’3”- 2’6”.

PRIMARY HUNTER - Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any hunter over fences classes. Competing in classes with fence heights 2’9” or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Separate classes will be offered for Junior and Adult riders. Fences 2’3”.

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER - Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any hunter classes over fences. Competing in any classes 3’ or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Separate classes will be offered for Junior and Adult riders. Fences 2’6”.

BEGINNER HUNTER - Open to riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized hunter over fences classes at MHJA, MHSA and/or USEF shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their beginner status for the current show season. Riders having won in the Beginner division do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. This division is not open to any rider who has shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Riders **may not** cross enter into any classes that require the rider to jump 2’6” or higher. Jumping 2’6” or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Separate classes for Junior and Adult riders. Fences 2’.

CROSSPOLE HUNTER & EQUITATION - Open to riders with limited show experience. Riders may not have shown in any classes 2’3” or higher.

BEGINNER EQUITATION—Open to Junior & Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized equitation over fences classes at MHJA, MHSA and/or USEF shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. See Beginner Hunter for further specifications. Separate classes for Junior and Adult riders.

PRIMARY EQUITATION—Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation over fences classes. Competing in classes with fence heights 2’9” or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Separate classes for Junior and Adult riders.

INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION—Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation over fences classes. Competing in any classes 3’ or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2’6”. Separate classes for Junior and Adult riders.

ENTRIES CLOSE SEPTEMBER 11TH

Entries

Closing date of entries is September 11th, 2010. After that time entries will be accepted with a post entry fee of **\$25**. After September 11th there will be no refund on stalls. Please be sure to mail in your complete entry form with an open check or payment to cover your entries. Juniors will need the signature of their parent or legal guardian to participate. Exhibitors are responsible for any errors or omissions on their entry forms. Make checks payable to Stoney Ridge Farm.

Stabling

Stalls will be **\$70**. Stalls will be reserved on a first pay, first serve basis. Stalls will be 10' x 10' with stall gates in permanent barns or vinyl stalls in the indoor ring and under a tent if necessary. No first bedding provided. Shavings will be available for purchase @ **\$8** per bag prior to the show. Stalls will be available Friday at 10AM .

Trailer in fees are **\$30** per day. Check with management for where to park your trailers.

Non showing horses will be charged **\$75** plus the EMT fee in addition to the stabling.

Class fees

MHJA recognized hunter and equitation classes will be **\$18** per class. MHJA Medal classes will be **\$25** per class. All warm up and schooling hunter classes will be **\$25** with **\$2** of each entry fee being paid to the class winner. Hunter classics will be **\$35**, unless otherwise stated.

Posted orders of go will be used in all medal finals and all classics.

Riders showing in classes not properly entered in will pay a rode not entered fee of **\$6** per class.

EMT fee is **\$6** per horse/rider combination.

Any non negotiable checks will be charged a service fee of \$50.

Schooling

Schooling will be available on Friday at 10:00 AM. Schooling will be available in all rings weather permitting. No schooling over medal courses.

Schooling will be available on show mornings until 7AM. No schooling after dark in any ring.

Campers

Camper fee is **\$70** for the weekend. Pay directly to Hunter's Run.

Ribbons/Trophies

In all hunter classes ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Eight ribbons will be awarded in all equitation classes including the medal finals. All classics will award ribbons through tenth place.

Championships will be awarded in all hunter divisions.

Prize money won will be deducted from the exhibitor's entry fees. Any monies owed the exhibitor will be sent to the owner of record unless other arrangements are made with the show secretary. Monies will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the show.

MHJA

This show will be run according to the rules of the MHJA. Any questions regarding the MHA rules should be directed to the Rules, Standards and Grievance Committee. Any rules not covered by the MHJA Rule Book will be referred to the USEF Rule Book.

Management

Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide classes if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Stoney Ridge Farm, Hunter's Run, the facility owners and their staffs will not be responsible in any way for loss or damage to any person, property, animal or equipment. Each exhibitor shall assume all liability and hold harmless Stoney Ridge Farm, Hunter's Run, the facility owners and their staffs for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or equipment that may be caused by any horse/pony entered by them or due to carelessness or negligence of the person in charge of such horse/pony or any of their subordinates or superiors.

Protective Headgear

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds (professionals included). Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until the headgear is properly in place. Stoney Ridge Farm and MHJA make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element or risk.

Dogs

All dogs must be on a leash at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the Observation Room. Please keep your dogs under control for the safety of everyone at the show.

PONY DIVISIONS

A rider who is eligible to compete in a division at the start of the show year will remain eligible to compete in that division for the remainder of the show year regardless of the number of blue ribbons won. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider **immediately ineligible** for certain divisions. All ponies must have a current measurement card to participate in this show.

SMALL PONY HUNTER - Open to all small ponies ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age and under. Ponies may not exceed 12.2 hands in height. Fences 2.

MEDIUM PONY HUNTER - Open to all medium ponies ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age and under. Ponies may not exceed 13.2 hands in height. Fences 2'3".

LARGE PONY HUNTER - Open to all large ponies ridden by Junior riders. Ponies may not exceed 14.2 hands in height. Fences 2'9".

CHILDREN'S LARGE PONY HUNTER - Open to Junior riders mounted on large ponies. Riders may cross enter into MHJA Open Pony divisions for the current show year. Riders become ineligible to compete in this division the following show year. Fences 2'6". No in and out.

CHILDREN'S SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER - Open to Junior riders mounted on small and medium ponies. Riders may cross enter into the MHJA Open Pony divisions for the current show year. Riders become ineligible to compete in this division the following show year. Fences 2'. No in and out.

NOVICE PONY HUNTER—Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won 3 blue ribbons in hunter classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. This division is not open to any rider who has shown in any open hunter and/or equitation divisions at MHJA and USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Open divisions include MHJA and USEF Pony Medals, Small, Medium and Large Pony Hunter divisions, age group equitation classes at MHJA and USEF shows, MHJA Open Junior Medal, ASPCA and USEF medal classes. Fences 2'. No in and out. No oxers.

SHORT STIRRUP PONY HUNTER - Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under. These riders may not have won 9 blue ribbons in recognized hunter classes over fences at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the current show year. Riders having won in the Short Stirrup division do not lose their Maiden or Novice status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA and/or USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Fences - Large 2', Small/Medium - 18". No in and out.

PONY EQUITATION 12 YEARS & UNDER—Open to Junior riders 12 & Under mounted on ponies. Fences - Large 2’9”, Medium - 2’3”, Small - 2’. Tests 1-9 over fences, 1-5,8 9 on the flat. (Rule XIV)

PONY EQUITATION 13-17 YEARS - Open to Junior riders 13-17 years of age mounted on ponies. Fences - Large 2’9”, Medium - 2’3”. Tests 1-9 over fences, 1-5, 8, 9 on the flat. (Rule XIV)

CHILDREN’S PONY EQUITATION—Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may compete in the Children’s Pony Hunter division for two years. Riders may not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation over fences classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Equitation divisions do not affect a rider’s eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF shows. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. This section will be split into two divisions, Children’s Large and Children’s Small/Medium Pony Equitation. Riders **may not** cross enter in both divisions. Fences - Large 2’6”, Small/Medium - 2’. No in and out, no tests.

NOVICE PONY EQUITATION - Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders **may not** have won 3 blue ribbons over fences in equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in the Short Stirrup division do not affect a rider’s eligibility for this division. In addition, riders **may not** have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF shows. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this division. Riders **may not** cross enter into the open equitation divisions. Fences 2’. No in and out. No oxers. No tests.

SHORT STIRRUP PONY EQUITATION - Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA and/or USEF shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year, but riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the current show year. Riders having won in the Short Stirrup division do not lose their Maiden or Novice status. Riders having won a blue ribbon in Short Stirrup Equitation on the flat are still eligible to compete in the Short Stirrup Equitation over fences classes. In addition, this division is not open to any riders who have shown in any open hunter and/or equitation divisions at MHJA and USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Fences - 2’, Small/Medium - 18”. No in and out, no tests.

MHJA PONY MEDAL FINAL - Open to riders who have qualified for the 2010 medal ride off. Fences - Large 2’9”, Medium - 2’3”, Small - 2’. Tests 1-19. One rider per pony.

MHJA PONY MINI MEDAL FINAL - Open to riders who have qualified for the 2010 Medal Final. Fences 2'. Tests 1-6. One rider per pony.

SPECIAL CLASSES

PONY WARM UPS—Warm up classes will be offered for each pony division..Entry fee is **\$25** with **\$2** of each entry being awarded to the class winner.

PONY HANDY HUNTER—Open to riders who have participated in the open pony hunter divisions. Entry fee is **\$20**.

All of the pony hunter classics will be run in a two round format time permitting. If a hunter class is used as the first round of the classic all riders will return for the second round. If the classic is run in the two round format the top twelve riders will return for the second round. The rider with the highest combined score will be the class winner. Entry fee is **\$35**.

SRF \$250 PONY HUNTER CLASSIC - Open to riders who are competing in the Small, Medium and Large Pony divisions.

SRF \$250 CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER CLASSIC - Open to riders who are competing in the Children's Pony Hunter divisions.

SRF \$250 NOVICE PONY HUNTER CLASSIC - Open to riders who are competing in the Novice Pony Hunter divisions.

SRF \$250 SHORT STIRRUP PONY HUNTER CLASSIC - Open to riders who are participating in the Short Stirrup Pony Hunter division.
